QUESTION I have a 2004 Dodge Stratus with 120,000 miles. The engine is running fine, but the car is making a noise that sounds like a rattling or clunking sound. It seems to be coming from the front end. What could be the cause of this noise?

ANSWER The noise you are describing could be caused by a variety of factors. It could be a worn ball joint, a loose tie rod end, or a worn strut. It could also be a loose wheel nut or a loose brake caliper. To diagnose the problem, you should have a mechanic inspect the front end of the car. They will check the ball joints, tie rod ends, struts, and wheel nuts. They will also check the brake calipers. If any of these components are worn or loose, they will be replaced or tightened. This should eliminate the noise.

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
